This letter is in response to your request dated November 27, 2024, regarding the release of certain Department of State (“Department”) material under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Department has identified 17 responsive records subject to FOIA. Upon review, we have determined that 16 records may be released in part and 1 record must be withheld in its entirety

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. The record withheld in full is exempt from release pursuant to FOIA Exemptions 6 and 7, 5 U.S.C. §§ 552(b)(6), (b)(7)(C), and (b)(7)(E). The document identification number for the record withheld in full is A-00001062916. Where applicable, the Department has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing these records and applying FOIA exemptions. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist. To the extent another agency asserts that it can neither confirm nor deny the existence of certain records, the Department of State will similarly take the position that it neither confirms nor denies the existence of those records.

The Chief Justice has used in the past but the costs were certainly lower then! The costs are roughly as follows and are per movement so arrival, departure or transit. I am clarifying these however as the suites are now back fully operational and they may have increased again:

1-3 people \$2,300
4-6 people - \$2,700

From my recent (Pre-COVID) experience most of the Supreme Court Justices we've assisted have just gone through regular channels with a member of the Visitors unit to assist. Heathrow does have Airline Lounges that can be utilized by the Justice if her ticket permits or if she has status with the airline or it's partners, there are also paid lounges available within the terminal building. Greetings, (b)(6) I hope this message finds you and your family well.

I should begin by thanking you and your colleagues in the Travel and Visitors Unit of Mission London for the many years of stellar support for the Breyers and the many other Justices who traveled through London over the years. It is always much appreciated.

I am the longtime (well over 30 years) USIA/Department of State Liaison to the federal judiciary. I work very closely with the U.S. Marshals Service and DS whenever a federal judge or a member of his/her immediate family (federal protectees all) travels abroad be it either for official or personal reasons to ensure they are well briefed, prepared to travel and have a safe and secure environment once they arrive at their destination.

It has been my honor and privilege to support Justice Breyer during his entire tenure as an active Associate Justice on the Supreme Court of the United States (28 years). This would include each and every one of his foreign trips. Even though the Justice has retired - he still maintains the title of Associate Justice, remains a federal judge, has a Chambers and staff at the U.S. Supreme Court and is entitled to federal protection (be it either the U.S. Marshals Service, the Supreme Court Police, local law enforcement, and in some instances our elite corps of Diplomatic Security Agents) - it all depends on the circumstances and threat analysis. Thus, I am copying the Mission London RSO Agents collective e-mail address on this message as well as GSO (b)(6) for their situational awareness and input.

(b)(7)(E) As you are aware the Breyers plan to depart for London on July 18 (b)(7)(E) (b)(6)

(b)(6) In the past your unit has kindly met and assisted the Breyers much to their relief. They have come to rely on a U.S. Government presence when they arrive in London (or any other foreign destination for that matter). Recently Justice Breyer's Judicial Assistant, (b)(6)

(b)(6) was informed that London was unable to accommodate the Breyers on this particular trip because it was "personal." (b)(7)(E)

(b)(6); (b)(7)(E)

I spoke with Justice Breyer recently and he was VERY concerned that Mission London was unable to accommodate him and (b)(6) as has been done in the past over the years. He is not all that comfortable with private expediter services - and in the case of the Breyers neither am I. Given the very chaotic nature of Heathrow Airport in recent summers past, with many American tourist travelers, the Justice could very easily be recognized, and security-related problems could potentially ensue. I assure you that the Breyers would feel much more relieved and comfortable with a U.S. Government official meeting and assisting them. The Justice was very, very emphatic about this matter.

I am been a Foreign Affairs Officer for 47 years and counting and know and understand the operations of our major Posts - I know what you all have to deal with. Mission London has always, always been supportive of our Justices and I am eternally in your debt. However, this is a serious security-related matter and I am respectfully requesting reconsideration that your Unit meet and assist the Breyers for the reasons stated above.

Furthermore, this really is no longer a "personal" trip. Justice Breyer has been invited to Israel for a conference and additional meetings and programming. Our Posts in Jerusalem and Tel Aviv will be heavily involved. While in Tel Aviv the Justice will meet with senior leaders of the Israeli government. Given the current situation as it pertains to judicial reform in Israel this is a very big deal. Justice Breyer will leave from London to Tel Aviv on/or about August 2. (b)(6) (b)(6) will not repeat not accompany the Justice to Israel. The Justice will then travel back to the U.S. directly from Tel Aviv and will not transit in London.

Justice Breyer has always, over the years, supported the Department and has participated in numerous public diplomacy-related programs the world over at my request and that of our Posts. He is now asking for our support in this instance and I hope Mission London can accomodate him and (b)(6) ANY related costs will be covered by the U.S. Supreme Court - no questions asked. (b)(6) we go back a long way and I hope you can take this request to the powers that be and secure a positive response for me. Justice Sotomayor may want to cross into Canada while she is on a visit to upstate NY next week. We will be staying in Ogdensburg, NY where we will depart on a pontoon boat with the final destination of Brockville, Ontario. This is supposed to occur on August 6 or August 7, 2022. We do not have any locations or itinerary for this visit yet, but it will all be off the record and we will hope to keep it low key.

Our assumption, based on previous Supreme Court Police details that have traveled to Canada, is that we will have to be (b)(7)(E) Can this be verified? We will have three agents on this trip that have official passports, so we are planning on sending those three into Canada with the Justice. Two advance via GOV and one agent on the boat with the Justice.

Because of the low key, off the record nature of this trip, we do not have any major security requests. However, we do want to make the proper notifications to the embassy, RCMP, etc... Additionally, if there's any possibility of expediting the customs/border crossing process, that information would be greatly appreciated.

Please let us know if you have any tips, advice, or guidance, especially when it comes to entering the country via boat. I'll be in the UK until 7/31, but please email or call me whenever needed.

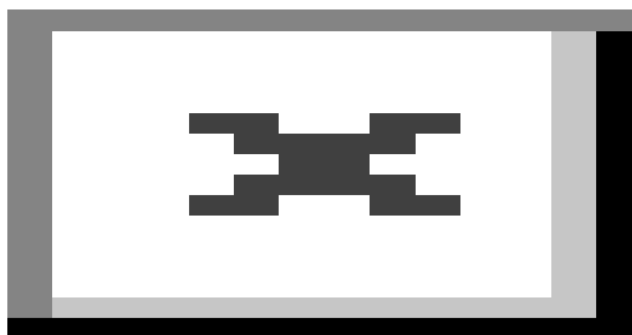
