Dear Mr. Roth:

As we noted in our letter dated March 18, 2026, we are processing your request for material under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Department of State (“Department”) has identified 10 additional responsive records subject to FOIA. Upon review, we have determined that all 10 records may be released in part.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. Where applicable, the Department has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing these records and applying FOIA exemptions. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.

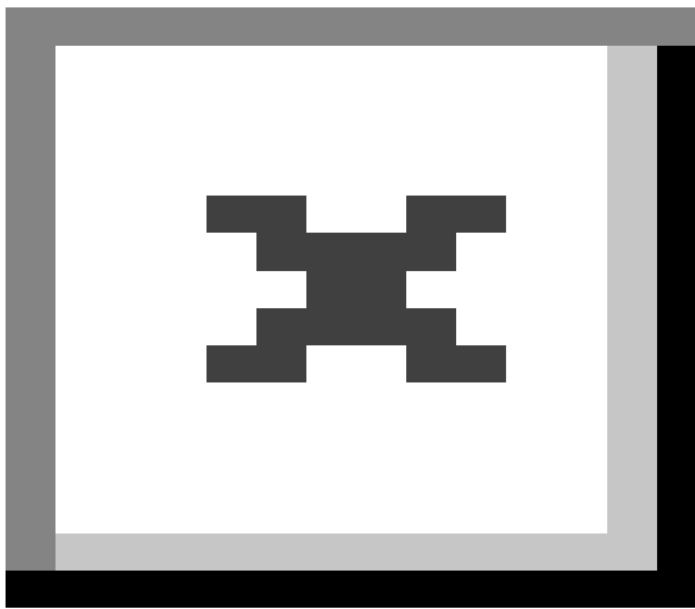

Re the VISAs, as of today,

- Diplomatic and Official passports need a Schengen (GR in this case) VISA (+stamping)
- Tourist passports do not need a VISA for Schengen (stamping upon arrival for counting 90 days free)

Also, kind see some comments/answers below (in red):

We have numerous requests and questions for the State Department in regards to this trip.

Our first inquiry is in reference to the Justice's layover in Athens on September 11th. She will have approximately 2hr and 55minute layover, respectively, at ATH Airport. For this layover, we would like to request an escort (VIP, Customs, security, etc...) and a private room or lounge for the Justice to wait to board her flight, if available. TBC- I will need to work with the Greek MFA on this.

Secondly, we would like to request assistance at ATH airport for both our arrival (August 29th) - I will need to have funds for overtime

and departure from HER airport on (September 11th). I will need funds to fly (+lodging +per diem) an expeditor from Athens to HER and back. Third-party service is also available (at a fee - but much cheaper than sending an Embassy expeditor to do it)

One of my colleagues spoke with a representative from the Greek Embassy in DC and was able to get an application, and they also stated that we needed an official letter stating the purpose of our trip if we are going to move forward with this process. However, DSS (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) seemed to think that the Visa application may get denied by Greece because the Justice's visit is unofficial, despite it being official business for the detail. With all that being said, we could just use some clarity on the situation.
