Dear Mr. Roth:

As we noted in our letter dated April 29, 2026, we are processing your request for material under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Department of State (“Department”) has identified 11 additional responsive records subject to FOIA. Upon review, we have determined that all 11 records may be released in part.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. Where applicable, the Department has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing these records and applying FOIA exemptions. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.

We will keep you informed as your case progresses. If you have any questions, your attorney may contact Thomas W. Greetings, (b)(6) I hope this message finds you and your family well.

I should begin by thanking you and your colleagues in the Travel and Visitors Unit of Mission London for the many years of stellar support for (b)(6) and the many other Justices who traveled through London over the years. It is always much appreciated.

I am the longtime (well over 30 years) USIA/Department of State Liaison to the federal judiciary. I work very closely with the U.S. Marshals Service and DS whenever a federal judge or a member of his/her immediate family (federal protectees all) travels abroad be it either for official or personal reasons to ensure they are well briefed, prepared to travel and have a safe and secure environment once they arrive at their destination.

It has been my honor and privilege to support Justice Breyer during his entire tenure as an active Associate Justice on the Supreme Court of the United States (28 years). This would include each and every one of his foreign trips. Even though the Justice has retired - he still maintains the title of Associate Justice, remains a federal judge, has a Chambers and staff at the U.S. Supreme Court and is entitled to federal protection (b)(7)(E)

Justice Breyer will leave from London to Tel Aviv on/or about August 2. (b)(6) (b)(6) will not repeat not accompany the Justice to Israel. The Justice will then travel back to the U.S. directly from Tel Aviv and will not transit in London.

Justice Breyer has always, over the years, supported the Department and has participated in numerous public diplomacy-related programs the world over at my request and that of our Posts. He is now asking for our support in this instance and I hope Mission London can accomodate him and (b)(6) ANY related costs will be covered by the U.S. Supreme Court - no questions asked. I am writing to update you on the sudden change in Justice Kavanaugh's travel itinerary. Due to unforeseen circumstances, **the Justice will now be departing on FRIDAY 23 SEPTEMBER 2022 via UA 0509 | FCO- EWR | 1255 departure.**

I have relayed this change to (b)(6) for airport movement purposes, but here is how this change will affect the rest of the team:

- We will still be arriving at the same time, and all meetings and operations prior to the Justice's arrival will remain the same.
- The Justice plans to be more involved in the seminar and seeing more during the day that he will be in Rome (since you are all on on-call status, this may only affect the amount of time that our Italian Police counterparts are with us or in our general area).
- He will check out of his hotel and depart on Friday, 23 September 2022 | FSNI/RSO/airport expedite assistance will be needed on this date *instead of* Sunday.
- My team and myself will check out of our hotel on Saturday, 24 September 2022 and depart a day after he leaves | this means we will NOT need drivers/vehicles/airport expedite/FSNI/RSO assistance 24-25 September 2022.

Hi (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) – likewise, I’m looking forward to meeting you and the rest of the team.

I’m glad you mentioned a meeting; I’d strongly suggest you and your team come to the Tri-Mission compound on Monday, if your schedule allows it. This will enable us to meet each other and ensure mutual understanding in terms of what to expect from each other for this visit. Like (b)(6); mentioned, I’ll be your ARSO POC while (b)(6); and (b)(6); will provide FSNI support. (b)(6); and I very much enjoyed meeting (b)(6); and his team yesterday to prep for Justice Barrett’s arrival this morning.

I am writing to circle back on Justice Kavanaugh's upcoming trip to Rome, Italy from 21 September to 25 September to attend the Notre Dame Judicial Conference. My team is currently in the process of applying for diplomatic visas and looking to request (b)(7)(E) permits, as Justice Barrett's detail is currently doing. In addition to these measures, we would like to coordinate Italian Police, FSNI, and vehicle support, along with requesting (b)(7)(E) access, just as the previous details have done. In regards to the information requested from (b)(6); the following key points regarding our official trip to Rome should be noted:

- The Justice and (b)(6); will be flying on a commercial airline (*UA 884/ FCO 885*).
- While it is possible that Italian interlocutors will be taking part in this seminar, I am unaware of any direct affiliation with the Justice. Additionally, there is no scheduled meeting between the Justice and the U.S. Embassy.

The Windsor suite cost is per movement, however, I will check on when this is a transit, as I have a feeling that the one cost covers the entire movement. Anyone traveling on the flights that wish to use the suite are counted as a travelers regardless of their role. So, yes you do count in the number of three or six etc...

The only other options are to use the airline lounge if you are traveling business class or have status. Each terminal does have pay lounges also. We would be present for the movements whichever decision you make, so if you use the regular channels, either myself or one of my team will meet you at the gate and walk through the system with you to the next gate – however, we can not jump any lines, this is purely a hand holding service.

The above is based on using Heathrow -we do not have airside access at Gatwick airport.

Dear all,

I have just checked the UK website and you do not need a visa to enter the UK on any US passport (tourist, official or diplomatic). If you are assigned to London then you do need one before arriving to post, however for visits under 90 days official or unofficial, visas are not required. You can apply for an exempt vignette – however in all my years here, I haven't known a visitor to apply for that. As we will be

meeting the VIP at the airport, please do use your official or diplomatic passports as that helps us in negotiating a smooth entry.

Our first inquiry is in reference to the Justice's layovers in London on July 18 and July 30, 2022. She will have approximately 90 minute and 150 minute layovers, respectively, at LHR Airport. For these layovers, we would like to request an escort (VIP, Customs, security, etc...) and a private room or lounge for the Justice to wait to board her flights. Secondly, we would like to request assistance at Edinburgh airport for both our arrival (July 18) and departure (July 30). Ideally, expedited security and Customs processes would be greatly appreciated – for the layovers in London, the only lounge that would be a private space, avoiding the terminal buildings would be to use the Windsor Suite – the suite movement would cost approximately \$2,300 for a maximum if three in the traveling party, the cost increases to \$2,700 for three to six travelers. This is a wonderful service, but it is at a premium cost. Please note that you will clear UK Border force at Heathrow so there will be no formalities or passport checks in Edinburgh. I have added (b)(6) from our consulate in Edinburgh to see if there is any additional courtesies he can secure for your arrival there.

As we get closer to the time, please keep in touch and we can provide specific details along with names and phone numbers of the Visitors unit team that will be on hand at Heathrow.

Thank you for the Travel Safety Report. Below are some additional questions we had regarding this trip. Our pleasure.

Our first inquiry is in reference to the Justice's layovers in London on July 18 and July 30, 2022. She will have approximately 90 minute and 150 minute layovers, respectively, at LHR Airport. For these layovers, we would like to request an escort (VIP, Customs, security, etc...) and a private room or lounge for the Justice to wait to board her flights. Secondly, we would like to request assistance at Edinburgh airport for both our arrival (July 18) and departure (July 30). Ideally, expedited security and Customs processes would be greatly appreciated. For all inquiries regarding airport courtesies, lounge access, and Edinburgh Airport assistance, please contact (b)(6)@state.gov our Travel & Visits Unit Supervisor.

In regards to transportation while in the UK, we had a few questions. First, we will be renting a vehicle in the UK. We were advised that the Embassy would have a contact to get the best pricing for rental vehicles. If that info could be provided, that would be great. Additionally, will we need to obtain international driver licenses to drive in the UK? Finally, any tips or advice on driving in the UK vs. the USA would be helpful. For all inquiries regarding vehicles, Motor pool, and driving instructions, please contact Mr. (b)(6)@state.gov, our Motor Pool Supervisor.

Next, we were hoping for some clarity on the VISA requirements for entering the UK. We understand that these requirements may vary based on using the Dip passport vs the personal passport, but any advice there would be valued. Additionally, do you have a recommendation on which passport the Justice should travel on? The first half of the trip is "official" for our purpose. Her participation in the conference is based upon her role as a Justice. However, the second portion of the trip is personal travel. Per the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961), travel on a DIP passport requires a DIP Visa in the passport to travel. We have never seen a VIP get stuck at entry due to a lack of a DIP Visa in their book. That being said, it is always safest to get the visa ahead of time (if you have time). Me, personally, I bring both and travel on the DIP. If they say no to that, then I fall back on the BLUE/Tourist Passport and get the 180 day stay without a visa.

Finally, can you confirm that we will NOT be permitted to carry (b)(7)(E) while in the UK? We can confirm that you will not be allowed (b)(7)(E) within the UK.

Attached to this email is a rough draft itinerary for this trip.

We have numerous requests and questions for the State Department in regards to this trip. Our first inquiry is in reference to the Justice's layovers in London on July 18 and July 30, 2022. She will have approximately 90 minute and 150 minute layovers, respectively, at LHR Airport. For these layovers, we would like to request an escort (VIP, Customs, security, etc...) and a private room or lounge for the Justice to wait to board her flights. Secondly, we would like to request assistance at Edinburgh airport

for both our arrival (July 18) and departure (July 30). Ideally, expedited security and Customs processes would be greatly appreciated.

In regards to transportation while in the UK, we had a few questions. First, we will be renting a vehicle in the UK. We were advised that the Embassy would have a contact to get the best pricing for rental vehicles. If that info could be provided, that would be great. Additionally, will we need to obtain international driver licenses to drive in the UK? Finally, any tips or advice on driving in the UK vs. the USA would be helpful.

Next, we were hoping for some clarity on the VISA requirements for entering the UK. We understand that these requirements may vary based on using the Dip passport vs the personal passport, but any advice there would be valued. Additionally, do you have a recommendation on which passport the Justice should travel on? The first half of the trip is "official" for our purpose. Her participation in the conference is based upon her role as a Justice. However, the second portion of the trip is personal travel.

Just to confirm, we will NOT be permitted to carry (b)(7)(E) while in the UK?

Finally, in reference to Intelligence reports, is that something that the RSO will be able provide? Or does that come from a different entity within DS?

7. **ECC** – It is my understanding that we do not have to complete an ECC due to the fact we are not associated with the executive branch. Does that align with your understanding/protocol for your office?
8. **Use of Force Policy** – If approved to carry a (b)(7)(E) would you be willing to provide me with your RSO's use of force policy?
9. **FSNIs** – If applicable, would you be able to provide contact information for these individuals?
10. **Visitors Unit** – On previous security details in other countries, we have used the services of the Embassy's Visitors Unit.. Is there such a thing, and if so, can I please have the contact information for it?
11. **GSO (General Service Officer)** – (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) mentioned that the GSO is a good resource for accommodations, logistics, vehicle rentals, etc. Is your office staffed with this position?
12. **MISC** – Are there any recommendations that you would suggest that I haven't already addressed?
