Dear Mr. Roth:

As we noted in our letter dated June 10, 2026, we are processing your request for material under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Department of State (“Department”) has identified eight additional responsive records subject to FOIA. Upon review, we have determined that all eight records may be released in part.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. Where applicable, the Department has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing these records and applying FOIA exemptions. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.

All, I feel the need to re-request that the complete arrival and departure information be provided so the airport support requirements for Justice Breyer can be approved by local government. FYSA, my office submits the request to the Italian Ministry of Interior for approval. MOI have repeatedly insisted that for all USG VIPs requiring any support, the total travel itinerary be presented before they make a move. Security support from MOI (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) but rather offers an official recognition and privilege to visiting VIPs, which includes the initial request on your submitted eCC. For expedited airport services, (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) then I'm sure that can be arranged, but without the total picture, I'm afraid it may be difficult to receive any support.

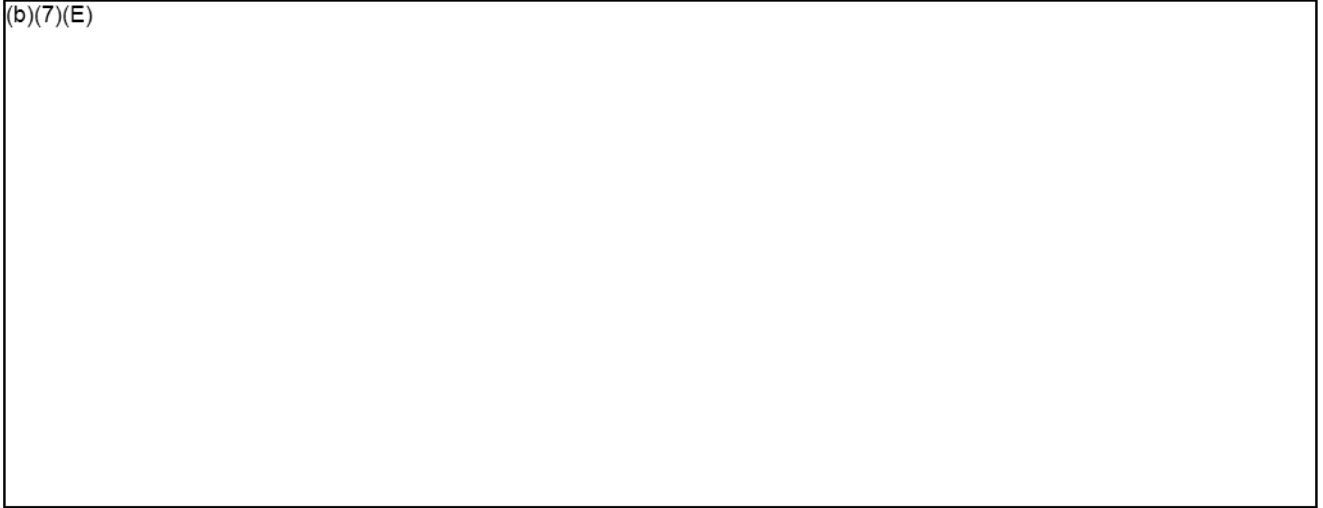

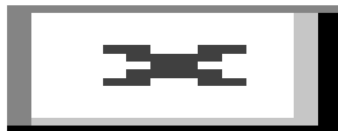
